I. Shoot circumstances

II. Camera settings

The camera model that was used is unknown and the examination of the EXIF data provides no indications.

III. Data examination

The photography shows a sunrise or sunset landscape. A strong focus blur is visible on it.

The object in the sky, which is bright and have an elongated shape, seemed to leave behind it a dark streak equivalent in length to at least five times its long axis.

Another object of the same appearance, but much smaller, is located slightly on the top left of the first.

It should be noted that the two objects are located under the cloud layer, consisting of cirrostratus (altitude of 4500-12000 / 14760-39370 feet)

IV. Conclusion

The lack of data from the photo does not allow us to draw any conclusion about the nature of the captured object.
